Blood pressure management in acute ischemic stroke remains problematic and questions such as when to start

antihypertensives and by how much to reduce BP are yet to be resolved. Although lowering BP is effective for recurrent stroke prevention, the degree of BP reduction may be more important than the class of the agent used.

Stroke has a global incidence of 15 million people per year, is the third leading cause of death and is the most common cause of disability in the western world.¹ High-blood pressure (BP) is the leading modifiable risk factor for both ischaemic and haemorrhagic stroke² affecting 1 billion people worldwide.³ In acute stroke, 75% of patients have high BP and 50% of those have a prior history of hypertension.^{4, 5}

At presentation, 60% to 80% of patients with acute ischemic stroke (AIS) have systolic blood pressures (SBP) over 140 mm Hg. 1-3 Patients with preexisting hypertension may have SBP magnitudes higher. 4,5 Commonly, this acute hypertensive response abates within 24 hours, returning to the patient's previous baseline over several days. 6 The return to baseline and rapid normalization of BP

after arterial recanalization 7,8 both underscore the physiologic role of the acute hypertensive response.

High blood pressure puts an extra strain on all the blood vessels in your body. This can make a stroke due to a clot (ischemic stroke) more likely, because high blood pressure damages your blood vessels and makes them become stiffer and more narrow. Following the acute phase of ischaemic stroke, blood pressure should be measured and treatment initiated to achieve a target blood pressure of <130/80 mmHg. Beta-blockers should not be used in the management of hypertension following a stroke, unless
