The Society has seen its influence recede from the high-water mark of 1970s, but

Throughout *The World of the John Birch Society*, the reader sees the very tenets and practices in play that make the contemporary Tea Party so effective on a local level. Indeed, without the John Birch Society paving the way, the Tea Party may have encountered a dramatically different political terrain on its path to power.
