Excretory System - Multiple choice

Kidneys are part of the urinary, or excretory, system in the human body. This is the system that helps us remove waste – such

as carbon dioxide, salt, excess minerals, toxins, and unused water – from our bodies. The excretory organs include the lungs, kidneys, liver and skin, but today, we are going to focus only on the kidneys (see Figure 2).

The excretory system functions to remove waste from the body. This can happen via two pathways. First, kidneys filter metabolic wastes from the blood and excrete them via urine. Second, organs of the GI tract (such as the liver, small intestine, and colon) filter toxic substances and waste products from food and excrete it via feces; therefore ...
