Zealand Company, which promised the chiefs of Wellington that, in addition to retaining their pa sites, kainga, cultivations and mahinga kai: "A portion of the land ceded by them, equal to one-tenth part of the whole, will be reserved by....the New Zealand Company....and held in trust by them for the future benefit of the said chiefs, their families, and their heirs for ever".
